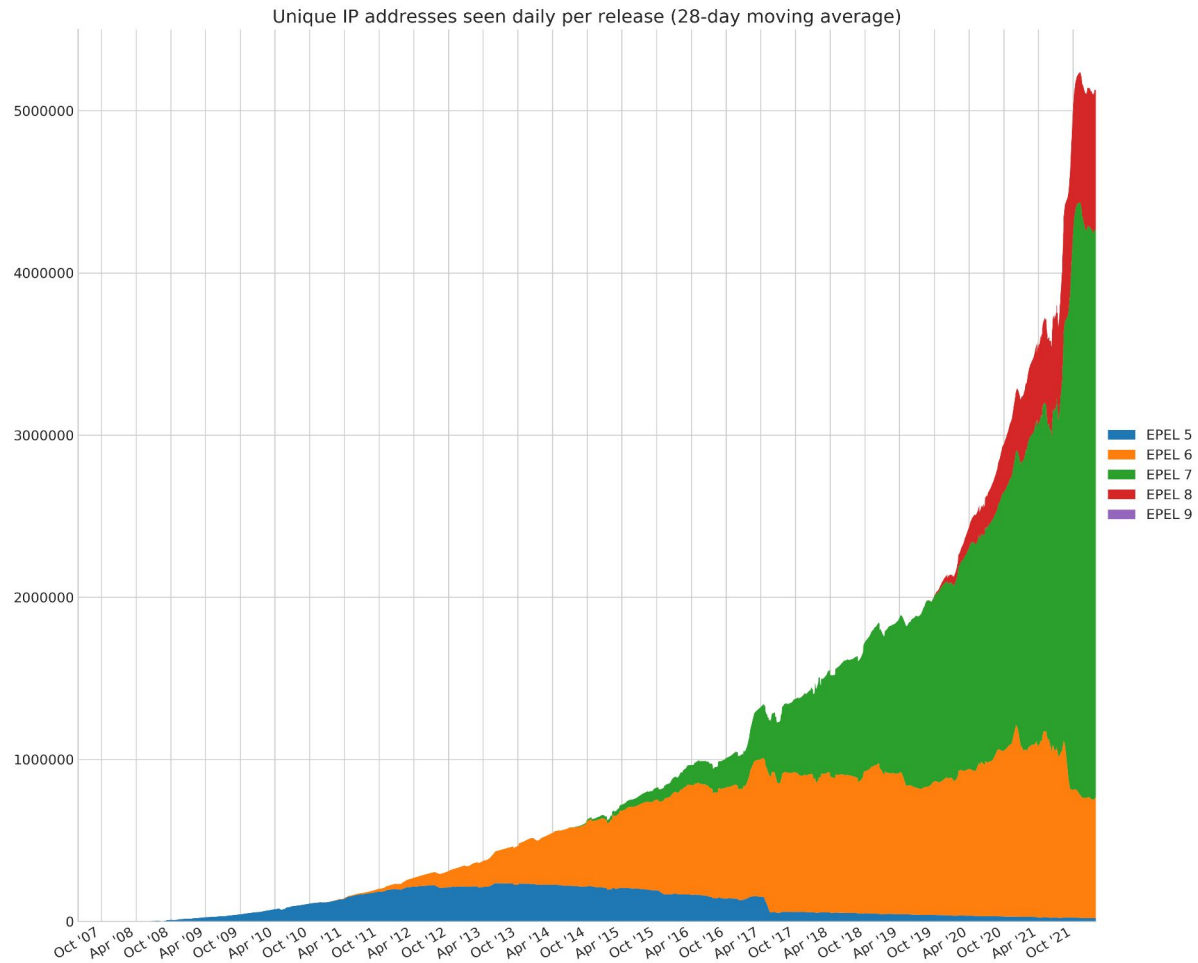

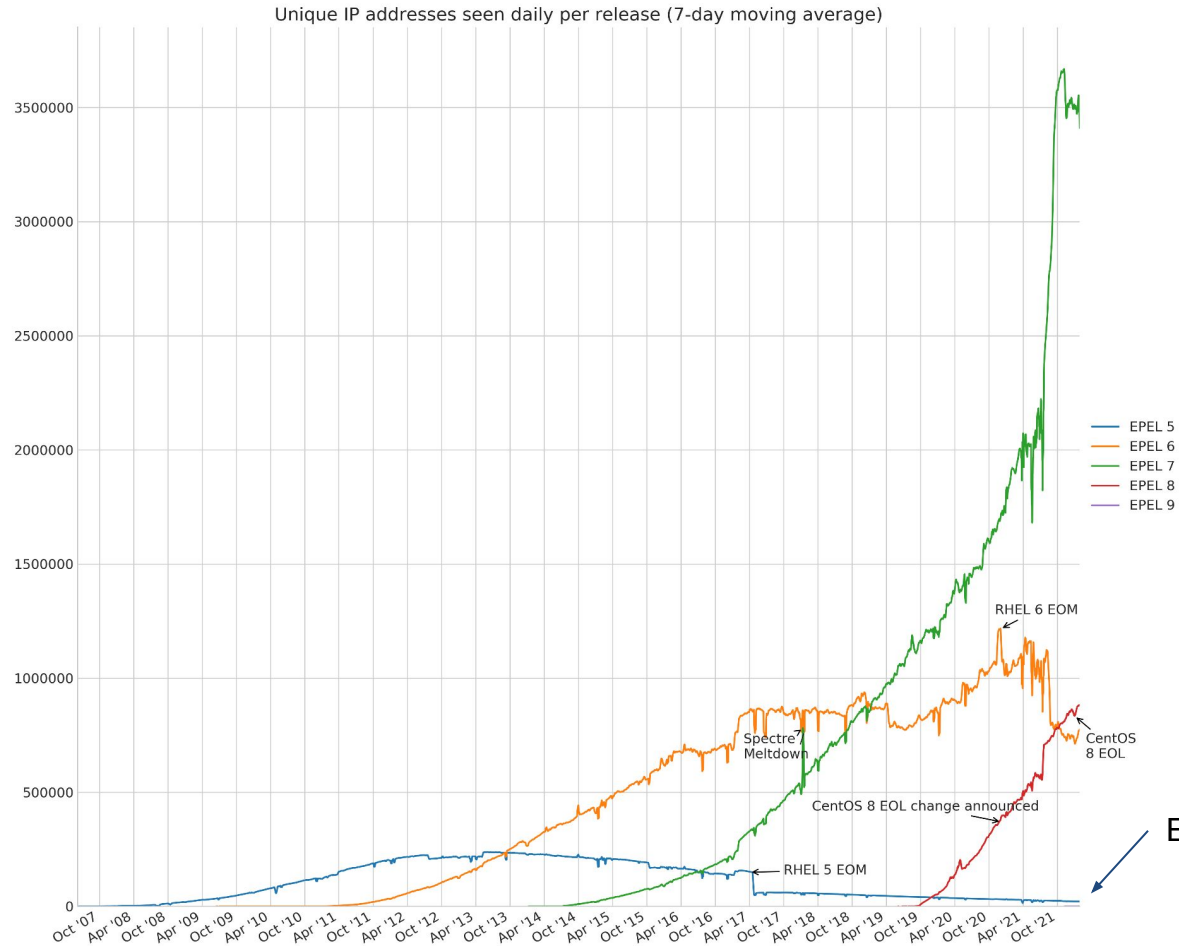
# Fedora EPEL Mirror Stats (Stacked)

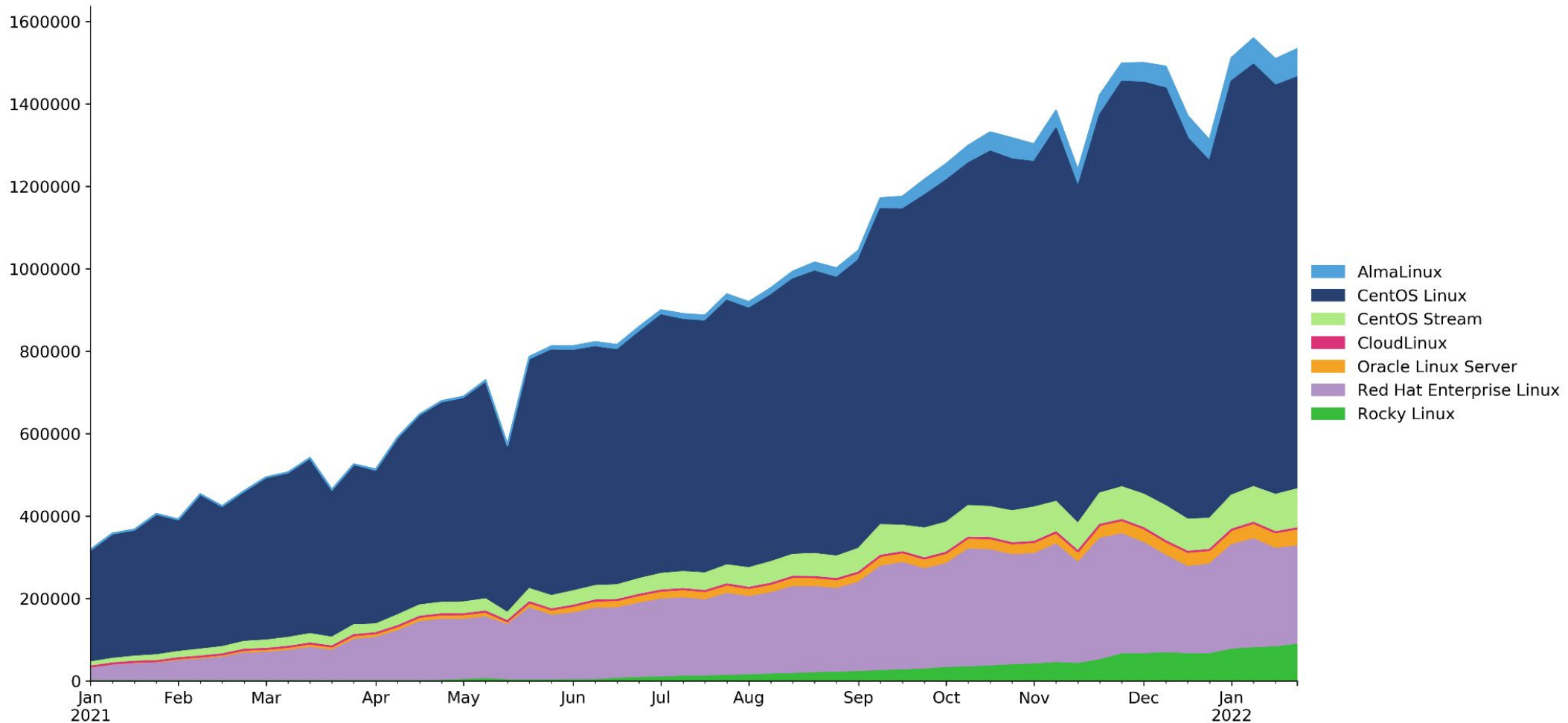

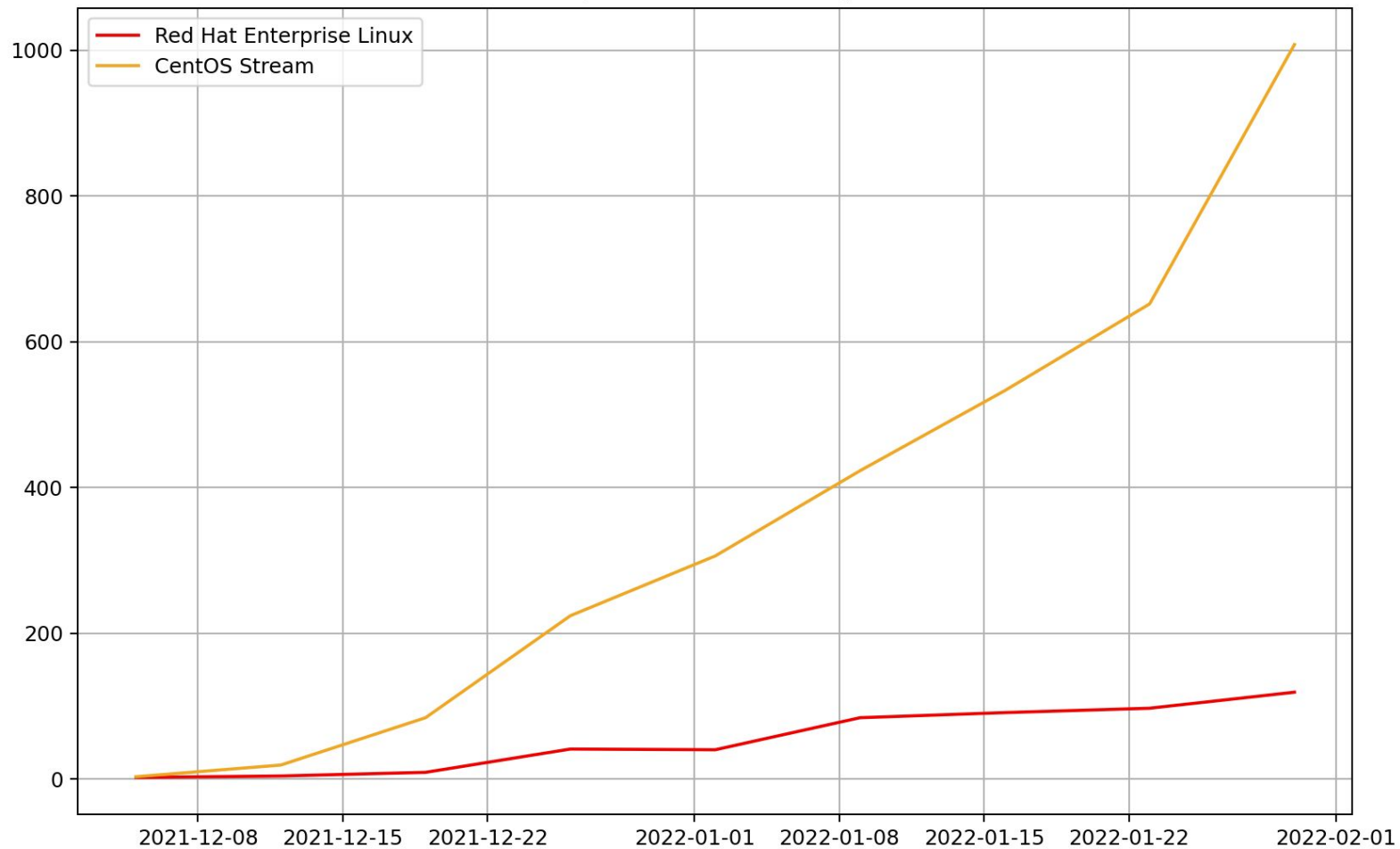

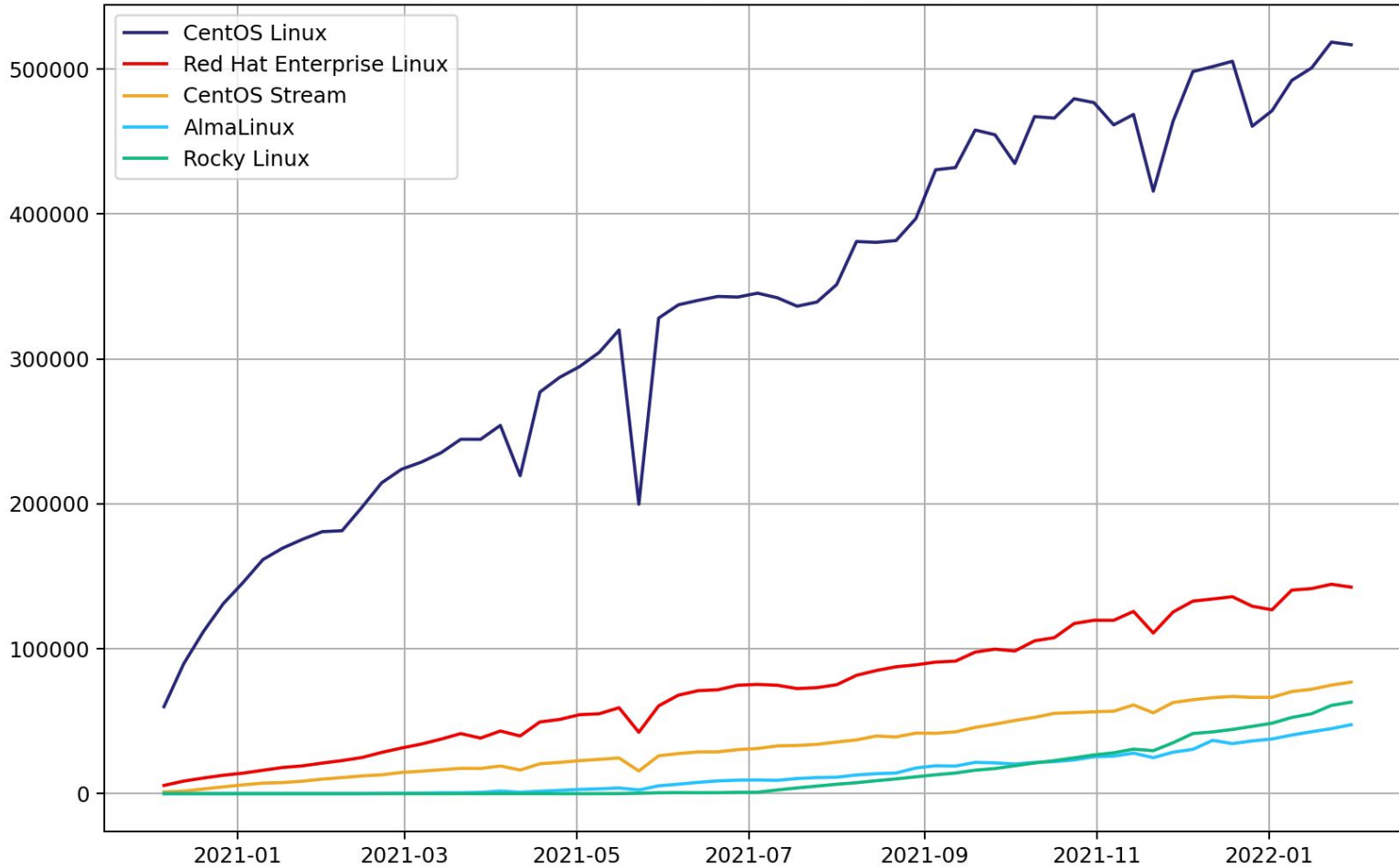
# epel: name over time (stacked)



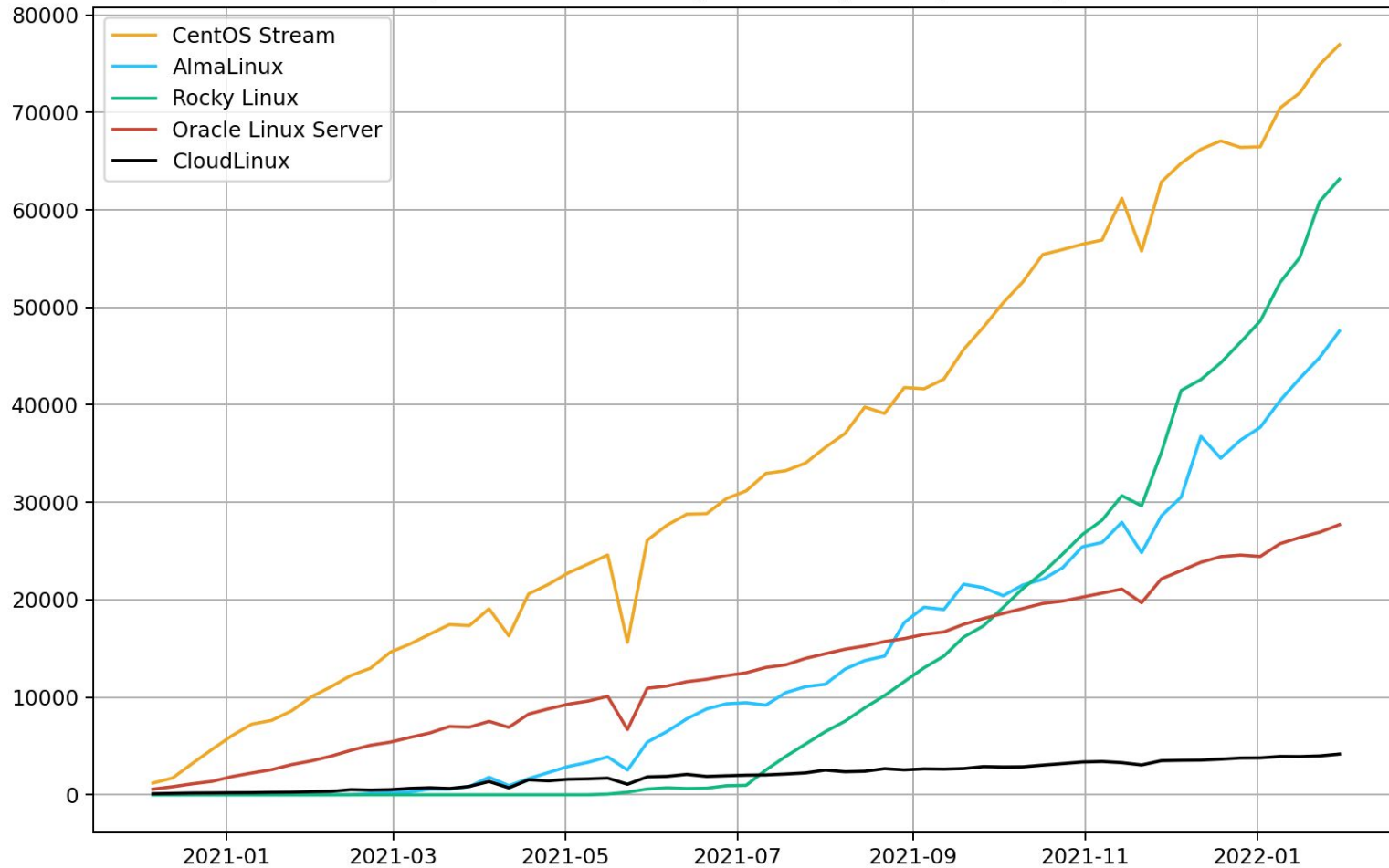
### EPEL9 dnf countme systems (older than one week)



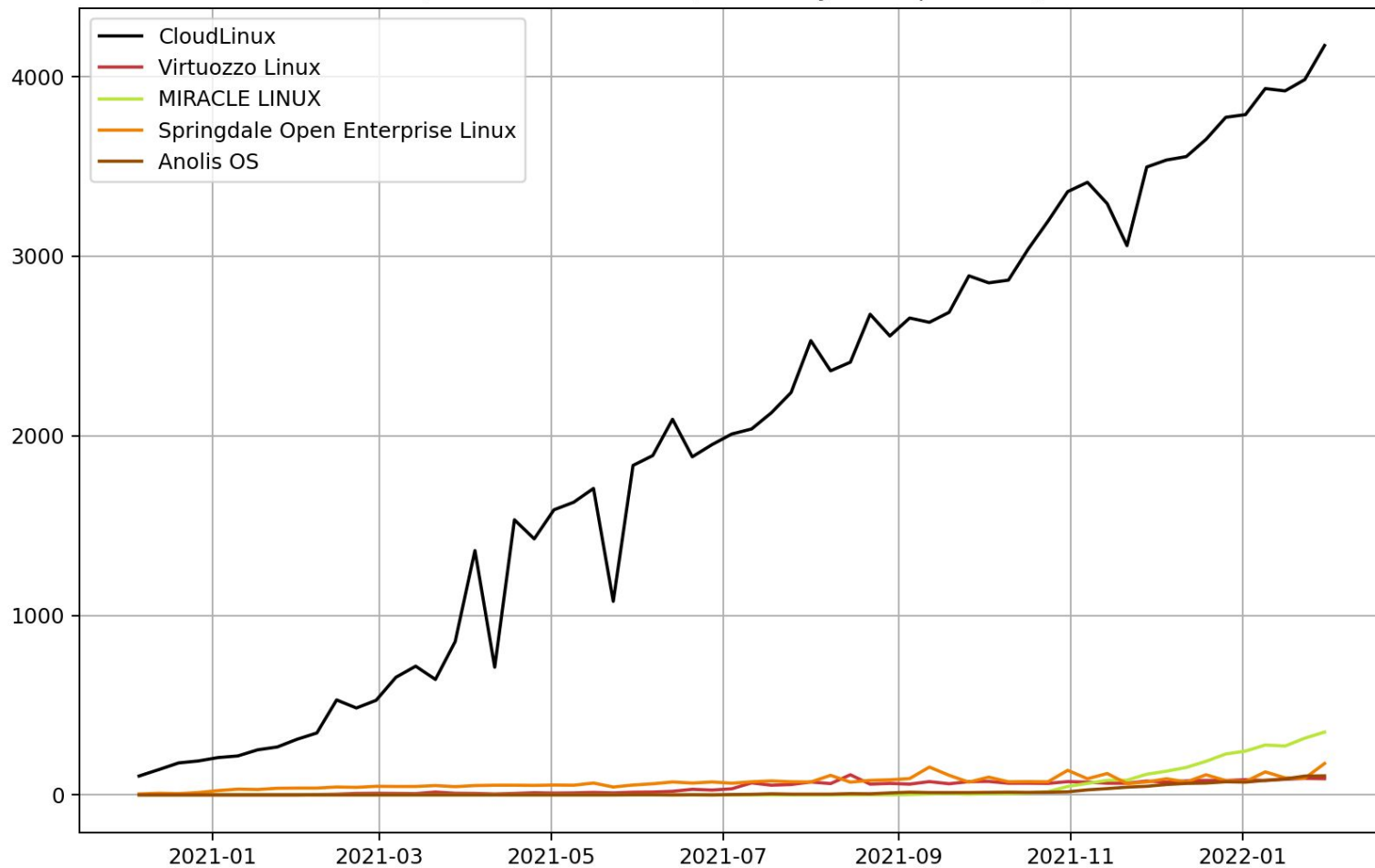
EPEL8 dnf countme systems

(older than one week, 1k-100k systems per week)

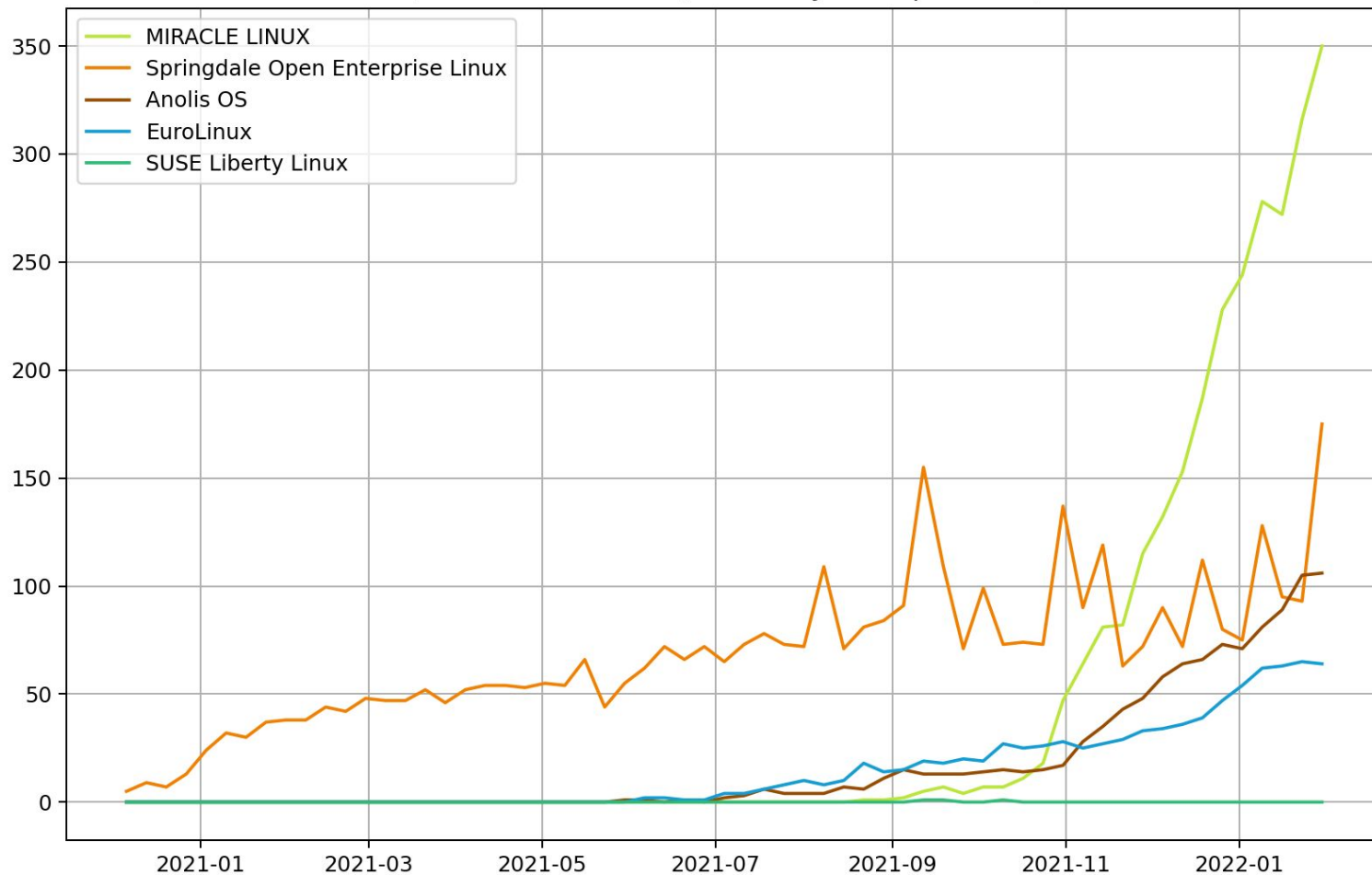


EPEL8 dnf countme systems  
(older than one week, 100-5k systems per week)

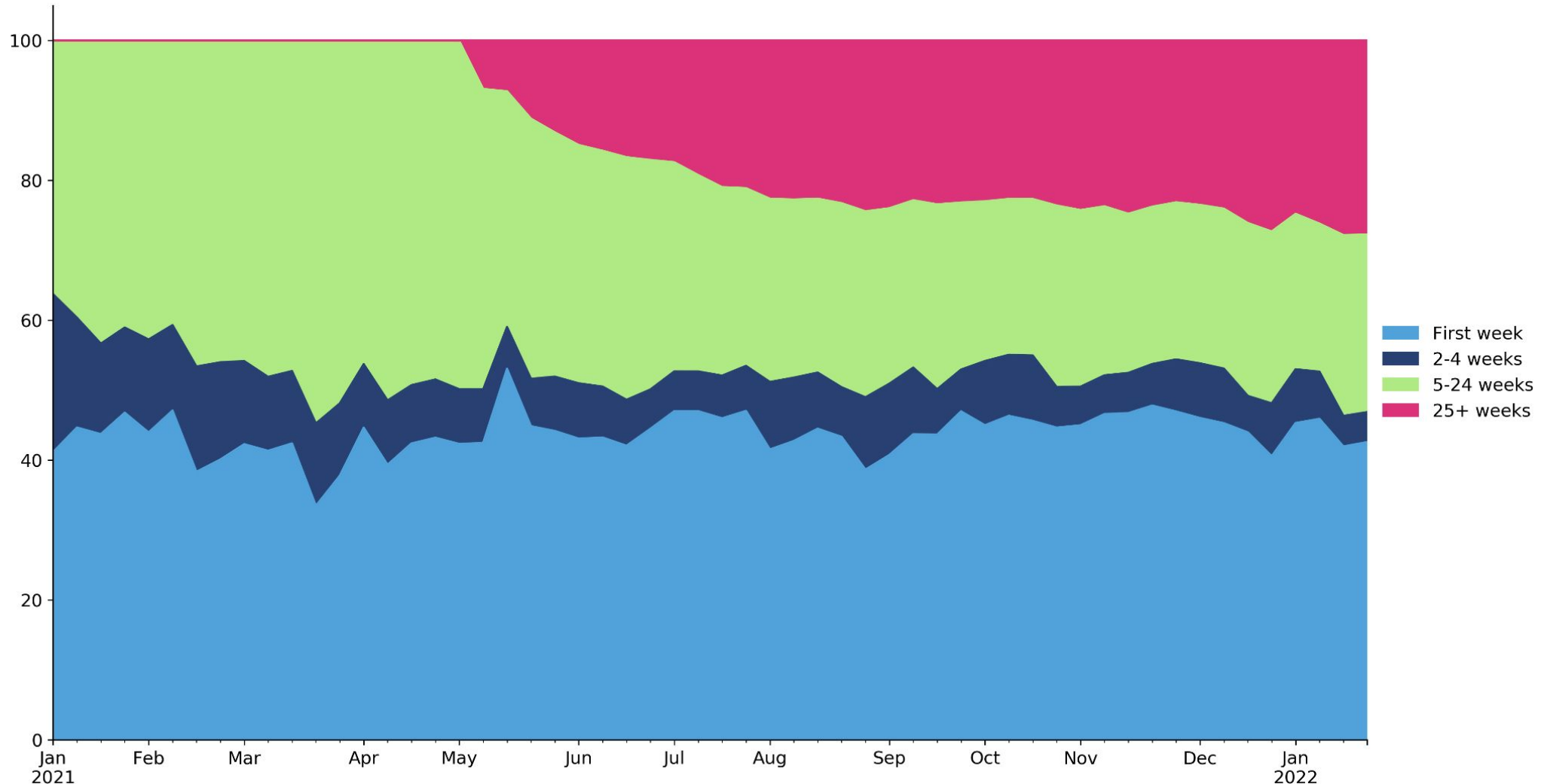




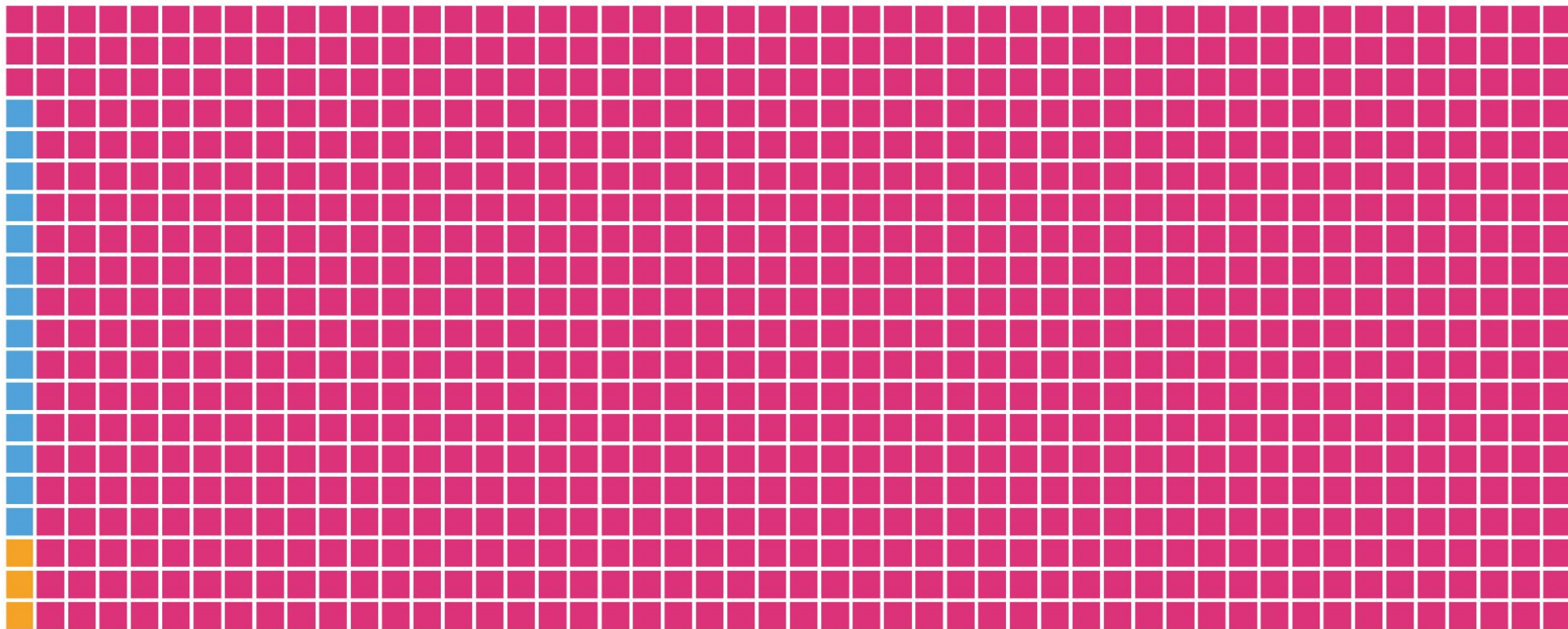
EPEL8 dnf countme systems

epel: arch for age 3

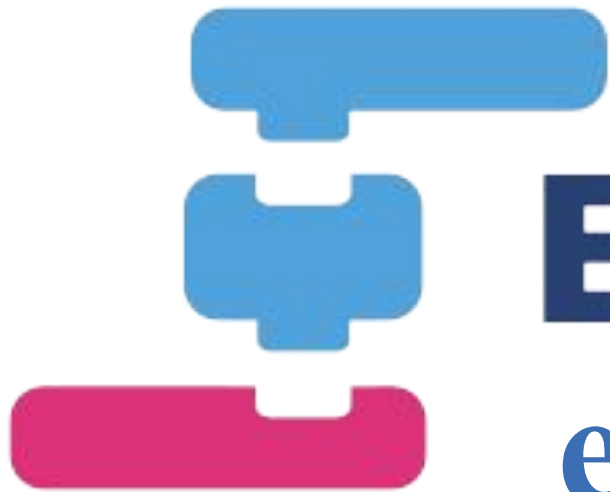

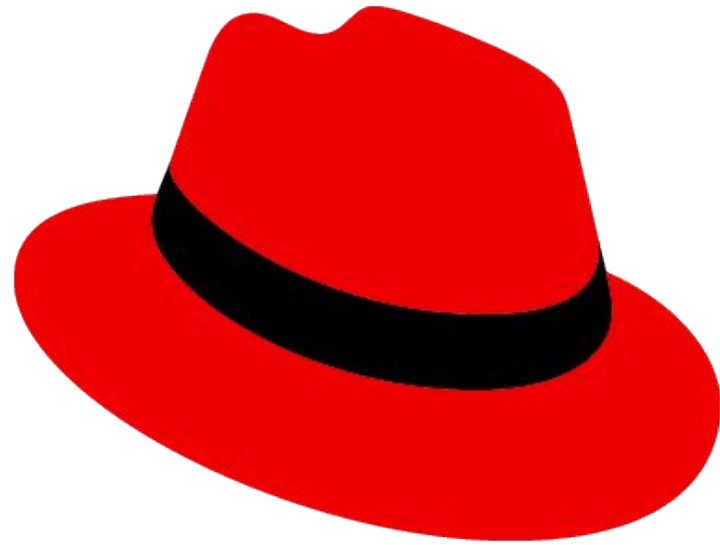


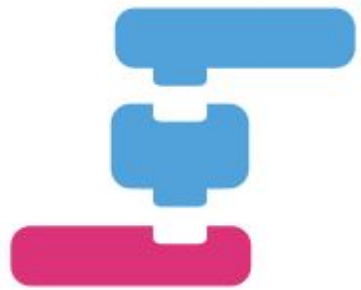
